

**JUNE 4 – FREE - TEST FLYING YOUR PROJECT – Whether Experimental or a Restored Certified Aircraft**

This one-day course helps the student prepare for the first flight of an amateur-built or certified aircraft following a restoration project. Additionally, the course helps the attendee prepare a meaningful flight test program. Among the many topics that are covered are evaluation of the aircraft, from weight and balance to performance characteristics, pilot preparedness and fitness, suitability of the airport, documentation and utilization of data from the test flights, communications between Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA) Flight Advisor and pilot during the test flights, and preparation of a Flight Manual or Pilots Operating Handbook (POH). Safety and emergency procedures are stressed.
